Bob Stump Endowed History Professor, Arizona State University

DR. EDUARDO PAGÁN is the Bob Stump Endowed Professor of History at Arizona State University. He was born and raised in the valley and began his college career at Mesa Community College. He received a BA from Arizona State University, an MA from the University of Arizona in US and Latin American history, and an MA and Ph.D. from Princeton University in US history. Before returning to Arizona, Dr. Pagán served as an assistant dean of students at Princeton, a faculty member at Williams College, and as a senior program officer at the National Endowment for the Humanities in Washington, D.C. He has held an NEH Fellowship and was a postdoctoral fellow at Wesleyan University and at the University of California, San Diego. His books include *Murder at the Sleepy Lagoon: Zoot Suits, Race, and Riot in Wartime L.A.* (Chapel Hill: University of North Carolina Press, 2003), *Historic Photos of Phoenix* (Nashville: Turner, 2007), and *Remembering Phoenix* (Nashville: Trade Paper Press, 2011). He is currently a co-host of *History Detectives* on PBS.
