DR. MICHAEL VINCENT was appointed Dean of the College of Arts and Letters at Northern Arizona University in 2006. Prior to his current position at NAU, his academic appointments included positions as Vice President for Academic Affairs and Dean of the University at the American University of Paris; and Dean of the Graduate School at Wichita State University. As a Professor of French, his academic credentials include an M.A. and Ph.D. from the University of Wisconsin-Madison; a Diplôme, degré annuel -- Mention: très bien from Université de Paris-Sorbonne, and the B.A. from Saint John's University. Widely published, his research focuses on word and image studies and textual approaches to seventeenth-century French literature. Beyond academia, he has assumed active leadership roles in such community and national organizations as the Flagstaff Arts & Business Alliance (Founding Member), and the Flagstaff Symphony Orchestra. From 1999-2000, he was a member of the Board of the Kansas Humanities Council.
